
April is National Child Abuse Prevention Month.

Often recognized with pinwheel gardens, you can make one at home!



What You Need:

Scissors
Push pin
Pencil with eraser
Colored pencils or markers to decorate

How to Get Started:

Cut out the pinwheel square on this page.
Decorate both sides of the paper.
Following the lines on the template, cut in from all 4 corners, leaving about 2 inches uncut in the center.

To Create the Pinwheel:

Gently bend (don't fold) one of the corners to the center point.

Skip the next corner, bending the next corner to the center.

Skip and bend until all 4 points meet in the center.

Next stick the pin through all 4 points and the back of the pinwheel.

Finish by sticking the pin into the eraser of the pencil.
