**A. Custody**

- 1. The child(ren), C C, shall continue under the custody, care and supervision of the Division, with placement as deemed appropriate by the Division, with the Division being authorized to consent to routine and emergent medical treatment; and with the Division being authorized to make announced and unannounced visits to the home(s) of the defendants, and to the home of the caretakers of the children;
- 2. The child(ren), T C and H J, shall continue under the care and supervision of the Division; with the Division being authorized to make announced and unannounced visits to the home of the defendants;
- 3. Legal custody of the child(ren), T C, shall be  transferred to/  continued with K K and S K and T R pursuant to FD-03-1133-19; and Legal Custody of H J shall be continued with K K and J J and Legal Custody of C C shall be continued with DCPD;
- 4. Physical custody of the child(ren), T C, shall be  transferred to/  continued with S K and T R pursuant to FD-03-1133-19; and Physical Custody of H J shall be continued with J J;
- 5. Physical custody of the child(ren), C C, shall be  transferred to/  continued with DCPD;
